Participation in The Studio Door's programs, which include working studios, exhibition walls and one-on-one mentoring are designed for mid-career and professional artists who are actively engaged in all aspects of their artistic practice, community involvement, and professional development. The Studio Door has limited opportunities so to be considered for an opportunity, interested artists are asked to submit an Artist Assessment questionnaire before being considered.

In addition to the assessment questionnaire, the following documents should be emailed to The Studio Door at **forallweknow@thestudidoor.com**:

- Artist Curriculum Vitae
- Artist Statement
- Portfolio of Recent Work
- Letter of Intent
- Letters of Reference (2)

Accepted artists will be required to present a City of San Diego Business Tax Certificate, California Department of Tax and Fee Administration Seller's Permit and Insurance (or Insurance waiver).

Artistic Background:

How many years have you been actively practicing as an artist?
Can you provide a brief overview of your artistic journey and major milestones in your career?

Artistic Practice:

Describe your artistic style and the mediums you primarily work with.
How often do you create new artwork, and what motivates or inspires your creative process?

Community Engagement:

In what ways have you actively participated in the local arts community?
Have you been involved as a member of any local arts organizations?

Marketing and Promotion:

How do you currently market and promote your artwork?
Provide examples of successful marketing strategies you have implemented in the past.
What is your business and marketing plan?

Grants, Residencies and Awards

Have you ever been selected for a grant, residency or major award?
Do you have any plans to pursue any of these opportunities?

Community Contribution:

How do you envision contributing to The Studio Door community and supporting fellow artists?

Are you involved in any types of community outreach?

How do you intend to attract patrons and contribute to the gallery's visibility?

Long-Term Goals:

Share your long-term artistic and career goals.

How do you see The Studio Door playing a role in achieving these goals?

Where do you see the arts community in 5 years in Hillcrest?
